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INDOOR SOCCER INFORMATION

The Sport

Action Indoor Soccer is a safe, fast, fun filled game for people of all ages. The rules are easy to pick up, and there are competitions for both mens and ladies, making it suitable for beginners right through to more advanced teams.

The Team

Teams consist of four players including the goalie. Up to substitutes are permitted.

The Uniforms

All players on a team must be wearing their same coloured shirts, penalties will apply if not wearing the same colour.

The umpire

The umpire controls the game, and operates the scoreboard. Players must respect the Referees decisions. Referees do not control the times of the game.

Game times

The soccer consists of two 16 minute halves. Fees must be paid before the game commences. Action Indoor must be notified of a forfeit 48 hours prior to the game, otherwise penalties will apply.

Behaviour

Each team member must keep language at a low level and games are to be played in a sportsmanlike manner so everyone enjoys the game.



Finals

Top four teams on each ladder play throughout the finals at the end of each season. Players must have played at least five games throughout the season to qualify and the team must have paid registration.

Competition points

The ladder positioning is determined by the points accumulated throughout the season. Points are gained through a win, or a draw.

4 points for a win

2 Points for a draw

1 bonus point for every 5 goals scored

For example, If a team wins 11 – 5, your team would receive 6 points, and the other team would receive 1.

Basic rules

Ball can be played off every net, ball cannot be stolen from side or behind.

Goalie cannot pass the ball across the half way mark on the full without player contact.

No player can enter the goalie's circle at any time. Any attacking player offending will result in the goalie gaining possession. Any defender entering without touching the ball will incur a free kick against. Any defender entering the circle and making contact with the ball, will result in a penalty shot for the attacking team.

The goalie is not allowed to leave the circle at any stage. If leaving the circle without making contact with the ball, the attacking team will win a free kick. If the goalie leaves the circle and makes contact with the ball, a penalty shot will be awarded to the attacking team.

Any further rules can be acquired from the Referee.

Substitution

Players can be substituted after a goal scored or during the break at half time. Substitutes are not allowed in the last three minutes of a half.
