

Junior & Secondary Soccer Information

Days and Times

Junior Soccer is run on Tuesday (Under 9s) and Thursday (Under 11s & Under 13s) nights throughout the school terms between 4:15 and 6:15. Secondary Soccer is held on Friday nights between 6:45 and 8:15. There are two seasons a year – Summer (Term 4/Term 1) and Winter (Term 2/Term 3).

Payment

The following are the options for payment:

Season Payment \$170 (includes both school terms)

Term Payment \$90 (includes one school term)

- A discount of 10% is applied to 2nd and subsequent children.

Season payments MUST be made by Round Two at the latest. If payment is not made (by the second week of each Term for Term payments) your child will not be permitted on court. If you are having difficulty with payment please speak to a friendly staff member on 9318 6777 to come up with a payment plan. Please note there are no other Registration or payments throughout the season.

We accept cash, EFTPOS or Credit Card payments. Sorry no cheques.

Uniforms

All teams must wear the same shade team shirt. Teams can organise their own uniform, or can alternatively have the centre organise team shirts at a cost of \$10 per shirt. Shirts must be worn every week or your team will be penalised a goal.

Unavailability

We understand that you may not be available for all games. If you are aware of a day you cannot play please give reception as much notice as possible as we may be able to change days/times. If you miss a week you may attend a Wednesday Hot Skills session (4.30-5.30) as a make up. Please inform reception of the Wednesday you wish to attend.

Most Valuable Player Award

During the past few seasons we have had a number of issues with Most Valuable Player Awards. This award was originally designed to encourage all kids to participate and try their best. After many unresolved issues about who received the award and when and how many times we are going to hand these out differently this season. All players will receive one award every term. The umpires will determine when the kids receive this award according to how they play and their improvements.

Substitutions

Most teams have extra players and need to sub on and off. The umpires will call for subs but it is the parent's responsibility to ensure that all children receive equal game time. If you need help with rotations and planning subs, please see the front desk and we can show you a system for either one or two subs.

Our Responsibility

Every week we understand that all kid's just want to play. We always attempt to get teams a game no matter what the circumstance. If it is not possible we will arrange a training session with an umpire during their game time. The team will receive a minimum of four points for their ladder. This is to fit in with our policy of providing fun and fitness to all players.

Code of Conduct for ALL

Players, parents, umpires and management set the tone for the conduct of a Soccer game. Every person is expected to make an important contribution to play the game in good spirit and fairness. The spirit of the game involves respect for:

- Your opponents
- Your team
- The role of the umpires
- The values of Junior Soccer (Fair, Fun and Friendly)

Appropriate action will be taken against players, parents or coaches who do not promote good spirit and fairness. Play well and have fun!

Hot Skills

Hot Skills sessions run on a Wednesday night between 4:30 and 5:30 for junior soccer players. These sessions are designed to build and strengthen soccer skills, and short games are sometimes played at the end of each session. Hot Skills is at a cost of \$9 per session, or \$3 for children who are registered in a junior soccer team at the stadium. No commitment to training is required, and you can attend sessions whenever it is convenient.
